Birdwatching competition this article concerns the birding competition. For the film, see The Big Year. A great year is a personal challenge or an informal competition among the birds possible from sight or sound, within a single year of calendar and within a specific geographical area. Popular in North America, the large years are commonly carried out within a single state of the United States or Canadian province, or within larger areas such as the lower lower states 48, within the official American Birding Association area (ABA), or sometimes the entire globe. The ABA record of 840 species was established by John Weigel of Australia in 2019. [1] The great world record of 6,852 species was established in 2016 by Arjan Dwarshuis of the first modern guide on the field of Roger Tory Peterson truly revolutionized the aviation. However, in that era, most birds did not travel widely. The first Big Year record of the known continent was completed by Guy Emerson, a business trips to coincide with the best birding seasons for different areas of North America. During his best year of him, in 1939, he saw 497 species. [3] In 1952, Emerson's record was broken by Bob Smart, which saw 515 species. [4] In 1953, Roger Tory Peterson and James Fisher made a 30,000 mile trip to visit the wild places in North America. In 1956, a 25 year old English named Stuart Keith, following the Peterson route Fisher composed a list of 594 species, a record that remained for fifteen years. [5] In 1971, Ted Parker, 18, in his last semester of high school in southeastern Pennsylvania, sent widely the seaboard of North America. That September, Parker enrolled in the University of Arizona in Tucson and found dozens of Southwestern U.S. and Pacific coast specialties, ending the year with a list of 626 species. The ABA Area was defined as the 49 continental U.S. states (excluding Hawaii), Canada, and the French islands of St. Pierre and Miquelon, plus adjacent waters to a distance of 200 miles from land or half the distance to a neighboring country, whichever distance to a neighboring country, whichever distance is less. Big year efforts were still few and far between. In 1973 Kenn Kaufman and Floyd Murdoch both pursued Parker's record. As recounted in Kaufman and Floyd Murdoch both pursued Parker's record. Murdoch's record was broken in 1979 by James M. Vardaman, who saw 699 species that year and travelled 161,332 miles. Benton Basham, in 1983, topped Vardaman, who saw 699 species that year and travelled 161,332 miles. In 1992 Bill Rydell made a serious attempt at the record and ended with 714 species for the year. In 1998, three birders, Sandy Komito, Al Levantin, and Greg Miller, chased Komito's prior record of 722 birds. In the end Komito kept the record, listing 745 species [6] birds plus 3 submitted in 1998 and later accepted by state committees for a revised total of 748.[7] Mark Obmascik's book about the 1998 big year record holder, became the first woman to break the 700-species barrier with a total of 723.[8] In 2010, North Carolina birder Chris Hitt became the first birder to see 700+ species in the lower 48 in a single year, finishing 704. [9] In the same year, Virginia Birder Robert Ake closed the year with 731 species, a total extraordinary obtained without the benefit of the relatively unique weather effects of 1998. [10] In 2011, Colorado birder John Vanderpoel became the fastest birder to reach 700 species in a year. In the end he managed 743 birds, losing the record of five, but completing what was, at the time, the second year of ABA in absolute. [11] Vanderpoel's effort was the last given without the main contribution of ebird and birdwatching groups on Facebook, which significantly improved the quality and quantity of rare bird sightings. In 2013, the Massachusetts Birder Neil Hayward reluctantly decided to make a big year of ABA. Hayward reached 700 species two weeks before the rhythm of 2011 of John Vanderpoel and closed his year on 747 species plus 3 provisional. [12] Two provisionals later accepted by the ABA gave Hayward a final total of 749, which set a new record of Big Year ABA. In 2016, four unprecedented birdwatchers attempted great years in the ABA area. A medical birdwatching of South Dakotan while "Olaf Danielson" launched its "big year", reaching 700 species in May. [13] John Weigel, an Australian conservative and activist of the devil of Tasmania, also launched his great year, called "Birding for Devils". [14] Not trying to beat the record, American birdwatching activist and Christian Hagenlocher blogger "The Birding Project" aimed at attracting more people from birdwatching through a more social perspective. [15] Hagenlocher, at the age of 27, also became the youngest person to break the barrier of 700 species for a great year of ABA. Photographer Laura Keene, leading a great photographic year of 2016, beat Lynn Barber's great recordWomen in September. [16] 2016 marked the first time that four Birdwatcher saw each one over 700 species in the ABA area in a year. On July 16, 2016, Weigel saw his 750th species, a Buller's Shearwater, breaking the previous of Hayward Hayward Hayward All four Birdwatcher in the end would have passed the total of Hayward. In October 2016, the ABA voted to add the United States of the Hawaii to the numbered area for the large years. All the great year 2016 Birder, except Hagenlocher Birded Hawaii during November and December 2016, even if the "new ABA" control list was not updated until November 2017. Olaf Danielson, partly due to the efforts to promote the conservation of the Birds in Hawaii, has incorporated the Hawaii in its great planning of the year, keeping a list for the "new ABA" together with her continental ABA list. John Weigel and Laura Keene subsequently killed Hawaii, with Weigel ends with the most High total for the "New ABA" region (836), the Region of the Continental ABA (784) and the United States (832). Danielson was close to 829 for the "new ABA", while establishing a new record for the 48 lower states (723). Weigel was biting the heels with 721. Keene broke the previous record for the species photographed with diagnostic photos of 792 species and audio recordings of another 10, out of a total of 815 for the year. On July 4, 2019, John Weigel hit 700 for the second time, and on July 5, Gaylee and Richard Dean once again reached 700 species for the year, making them the first birders ever top 700 species in the ABA area three times. At the top of this, the three years have been made consecutively. At the end of July 2019 Weigel became the first birder to reach 750 species in more than a year. A trip to Alaska at the end of August 2019 allowed David and Tammy McQuade to become the 4th and 5th birdwatching to reach 700 species during 2019. They joined the Deans as the only couples to make the company. With a trip to Maine in September, Amanda Damin became the 6th birder to reach 700 for the year, an unprecedented event in the history of ABA Big Year. In November 2019 David and Richard and Gaylee Dean became the 9th and 10th birder to have a 750+ ABA Big Year. In November 2019 David and Tammy McQuade became the 6th and 7th birdwatching to identify 700 species in Lower 48, and in December 2019 Gaylee and Richard Dean became the eighth and 9th birdwatching to accomplish that enterprise. A new ABA Big Year record was established on December 23, 2019, when John Weigel found an Eider of Steller in Alaska, especially #837 for the year. The same species also allowed Weigel to set a new record for a big year of the United States. At the end of the year it was 836 for this category. Large Years in 2020 were certainly influenced by pandemic. Alaskan tours were canceled, the trip to and from Canada was almost non-existent, and the use of air travel was minimal. At the age of 21, Ben Sanders was the youngest birder to reach 680 for a Low 48 (Contiguo) Great Year, and did so without a single plane trip. [24] 2014 saw the first continent-wide "green year", a big year executed with a minimum of environmental impact. In his rather extreme instance, Dorian Anderson bicycled 17,830 miles around the United States, amassing a self-powered, petroleum-free 618 species during his 365 days on America's roads. Dorian visited 28 states (some twice) during his adventure and, beyond his species total, raised \$49,000 for habitat conservation. He shunned all motorized transportation for the entire adventure, refusing even ferries that would have saved him sometimes hundreds of miles of riding around various bodies of water. He was hit by a car once, and almost hit several other times, but survived the entire year without major injury. [25] In 2021, Niky Carrera Levy and Mauricio Ossa, a couple of publicists and photographers made the first Big Year in Colombia, the country with the largest number of birds recorded in the world. They managed to record 1,453 species, the highest count of birds in one year in a single country. They traveled the 32 departments of Colombia in 21,974 miles. In addition to counting birds, they carried a message of conservation with the Colombia and they got 789 children to take the oath of guardian of the birds.
